### **News and appeals**

49 arrests were made over the weekend in Arun and Chichester. The offences included:- actual bodily harm, affray, drink driving, domestic assault, common assault, shop-lifting, wanted on warrant, possession of class B drug, fraud, public order and drunk and disorderly.

### **Crime summary**

#### **Chichester (WC1)**

Terminus Road, Chichester – Overnight on Wednesday 20 December, a storage container was broken into and a battery operated impact gun stolen. Serial 0645 of 21/12.
